

# Southern Alberta PES Outstanding Engineer Award

**Purpose:** To recognize outstanding contributions to the power engineering profession at the local level.

Contributions may be technical, educational, or service in nature, or a combination of these. Examples include:

- Outstanding technical contributions to the power engineering profession.
- Outstanding professional and leadership contributions to the power engineering profession
- Significant contributions to the local community representing the power engineering profession.
- Outstanding contributions in the area of power engineering education.
- Service to the Power & Energy Society and/or IEEE.

**Categories:** One award will be given annually, in each of the following categories:

- 15 or fewer years of professional experience
- More than 15 years of professional experience
  
- Years of experience will be measured from the completion of an undergraduate engineering degree.

## Eligibility:

- Nominator must be an IEEE member of Member, Senior Member or Fellow grade.
- Nominee must be an IEEE member and PES member, of Member, Senior Member, or Fellow grade.
- Both Nominator and Nominee must be members of the Southern Alberta Section (reside within its boundaries).

- Members of the Selection Committee are ineligible to act as a nominator, or receive the award.
- Self-nominations will not be accepted.

## Important Dates:

- Mar 14, 2016 – Nomination period begins
- May 31, 2016 – Nomination period ends
- June 30, 2016 – Successful recipients and nominators will be notified by email
- Sept 26, 2016 – Awards will be presented at the PES/IAS Chapter’s evening technical seminar, to be held at the University of Calgary’s Downtown Campus.

**Selection Process:**

- The Selection Committee will be composed of 3 members, consisting of the Southern Alberta PES/IAS Chapter's Chair, Vice Chair and Past Chair.
- All nomination forms must be complete, and contain all information requested. Incomplete forms will not be considered.
- All nomination forms will be screened to ensure both nominator and nominee meet the eligibility criteria listed above.
- Award recipients will be selected based on the strength of the nomination.
- Successful recipients and nominators will be notified of the selection by June 30, 2016.
- Successful recipients and their respective nominators will be invited to the award presentation on Sept 26, 2016.
